

Search for Full Professor and Doctor of Social Work Program Coordinator at Florida Atlantic University School of Social Work

Required qualifications: Ph.D in Social Work or an earned Doctorate in a closely related and a Master's degree in Social Work from an accredited school of social work required. Ph.D in Social Work preferred. This is a DSW Clinical degree, and applicants are expected to be able to provide leadership, and teach in, a clinically based DSW. Two or more years' of post-master's degree, clinical practice experience is the typical threshold expectation for teaching in a clinical program.

The candidate will be required to coordinate and provide leadership to the newly established Doctor of Social Work program at our School, which is unique to the state of Florida. Experience with curriculum development and implementation at the graduate level is essential. The ideal candidate will be a senior faculty member who has a national and/or international record of excellence in research; demonstrated ability to work inter-professionally in research and teaching; successful grant writing and sponsored research; strong capacity and background to advise and mentor doctoral students and junior faculty; leadership skills and style that foster a supportive and intellectually rich environment for students, faculty and staff.

The School of Social Work has both BSW and MSW programs, and a newly established DSW program. The BSW program currently enrolls more than 500 students. The MSW program enrolls more than 290 students. The School's faculty, students, and alumni are well respected within the University and across the south Florida community. We have a bright, compassionate, and committed team of faculty members. Transcripts for faculty positions must be an official copy scanned into an electronic format and attached to the application. Degrees from outside the United States must be validated by an organization belonging to the *National Association of Credential Evaluation Service* (NACES), with an indication of the documents the evaluation was prepared from (official transcripts, diplomas, dissertation abstracts). The evaluation should be scanned and electronically attached to the application.
