

NADD Social Justice Fund Administration

Fund purpose

To provide resources to individuals and programs to develop initiatives that serve the NADD membership in advancing social justice curriculum and scholarship in our academic programs and communities.

Procedures

The NADD president will appoint a three-person sub-committee to oversee the proposal process. The subcommittee will develop an annual call for proposals based on the committee's perception of current need. The committee may also elect to issue "off-cycle" calls based on emergent needs, but the primary process will include a fixed window annual request.

The committee is advisory to the NADD president and NADD board and will recommend funding proposal requests to the board for approval.

The committee is responsible for notifying the NADD treasurer when fund disbursement is required.

The NADD treasurer will make an annual recommendation regarding the need for fund raising for the coming budget year.

Typical proposal funding amounts will range from \$2,500 - \$5,000. The subcommittee will make a recommendation for the amount and number of proposals to fund.

All proposals must include a dissemination plan, and considerable weight will be given to the capacity of the plan to broadly benefit NADD membership.

The committee is responsible for notifying applicants of the outcome of the review and for overseeing the satisfactory completion of the funded proposals.
