



## **Assistant/Associate Professor of Social Work**

The University of Alabama School of Social Work invites applications for two faculty appointments at the rank of either Assistant or Associate Professor to begin August 2020. Areas of expertise are open. Successful candidates should have (1) a strong record of scholarship, (2) the potential to secure external funding, (3) a commitment to teaching and mentoring graduate and undergraduate students; and (4) a demonstrated experience with, knowledge of, and sensitivity to the needs of culturally diverse and underrepresented populations and communities. Both positions require a Ph.D. in Social Work or a closely related discipline, an MSW, and a minimum of two years post-MSW practice experience.

The University of Alabama's School of Social Work, established in 1965, has an accomplished faculty of 23 tenured and tenure-track faculty members, 13 full-time teaching faculty members, and over 30 dedicated professional and support staff members. We have a vibrant student body with a combined enrollment of over 600 students across our BSW, MSW, DSW, and PhD programs.
